## **PRE/PEST CONTROL EXERCISE PRECAUTIONS/INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1 Put away or cover food, cooking utensils, toothbrushes, children's soft toys and other items that people or pets may put in their mouth.
- 2 Remove all kitchen/pantry utensils from the kitchen cabins i.e. plates, cups, cutlery etc inclusive of the cabin liners. (This should be directed to the concerned staff on duty). In addition all office desks, drawers, pantries, filing cabinets should be emptied such that our technicians can access all the potential pest harborages.
- 3 The liners from the kitchen cabins/desks should be disposed off immediately as they contain pest eggs.
- 4 In the rest of the premises, remove all office/household furniture a few inches off the wall such that we can gain access to the entire skirting of the inside of the premises.
- 5 Ensure that all manholes are accessible by our technicians as they are a perfect breeding ground for roaches and sewer rodents as well as all offices and stores.
- 6 In case you have any pets like dogs or cats please lock them safely away in their kennels or any other safe room. You may release them at least two hours after the pest control exercise, the longer the better, when all the pesticide residues have dried away to prevent being leaked by the pets.
- 7 Evacuate the premises and leave minimum staff on site children, the elderly and persons with allergies are more vulnerable to exposure to pesticides, they should be evacuated at least two hours before the pest control exercise and be returned to the premises after two or more hours after the exercise -the longer the better.
- 8 Let our technicians gain full access to the entire premises, i.e. all offices/rooms should be opened and all drawers, pantries, offices desks should be accessible. Failure to access the above areas would render the service less effective
- 9 If the pesticide is to be applied outdoors, ensure that all the building doors and windows are closed.

## **POST- PEST CONTROL PRECAUTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1 If the pesticide has been applied indoors, ensure that bench tops and kitchen utensils are thoroughly cleaned prior to food preparation and ventilate the house, by opening all doors and windows, for a few hours upon return
- 2 Dead roaches and ants should be swept out of the cabins after at least an hour with a straw broom. NB: do not clean them out with a piece of cloth as this will clean off the spray as well.
- 3 The pesticide sprayed in the kitchen cabins should not be wiped off at all. When the spray dries, (after an hour) staff should simply apply fresh liners and return the utensils.
- 4 Fresh kitchen/cabin liners should be applied. The old ones should be discarded.
- 5 The kitchen utensils i.e. plates, cups, cutlery etc should be returned back after at least two hours, the longer the better.
- 6 The Pesticide sprayed along the skirting of the rest of the premises should not be wiped off as it leaves a perfect breeding ground for roaches and ants in the cracks and crevices. The rest of the floor could be cleaned after at least an hour i.e. in the middle area.
- 7 Rodenticides placed in the dark hiding corners of the premises i.e. behind the cookers, fridges, beds, drawers, pantries, filing cabinets etc do not touch or expose them to water or dust as this will greatly reduce on their effectiveness and cause bait shyness by rodents.
- 8 Rodenticides or rodent bait boxes should not be moved, touched or removed by non authorized staff at all times.
- 9 If any dead rodents are identified, they should be picked up with the use of gloves and disposed off in pit latrine, buried or burned as soon as possible or call M&N and a technician will be sent to remove it.
- 10 The next pest control exercise should be done after every three months from the last date. After the first two weeks, you should not be having any pest problem. If any, call M&N and we arrange for a follow up of the problem areas at no extra cost.
- 11 Do not leave food sources exposed for long periods particularly overnight.
- 12 Do not leave exposed unwashed food containers overnight.
- 13 Do not allow food debris to accumulate. Danger areas include spaces under shelves, pantries, desks, or behind pantries, cookers and refrigerators.
- 14 Dispose off all packing materials immediately.
- 15 Do not leave food materials locked in office desks e.g. sugar, cakes and takeaway etc.
- 16 Put rubbish in containers with close fitting covers and empty regularly. Keep rubbish storage areas tidy.

17 In store rooms, staff goods about 12 – 18” (0.3 – 0.5m) away from the walls to allow free access to the area behind for inspection and cleaning.

18 Don't eat from the office desks.
